I. Twelve Month Employees

- A. Timesheets are due in the Finance Department by 10:00 A.M. the 1st and 16th of each month for the preceding payroll period.
- B. Checks shall be issued on the 1st and 16th of each month with the following exceptions:
 - 1. Last work day in December rather than January 1st.
 - 2. June 30th rather than July 1st.

II. Ten Month Employees

- A. Timesheets are due in the Finance Department by 10:00 A.M. the 1st and 16th of each month for the preceding payroll period.
- B. Checks shall be issued on the 1st and 16th of each month with the following exceptions:
 - 1. Last work day in December rather than January 1st.
 - 2. The balance due for fiscal year earnings is to be issued on June 16th.

III. Summer School Employees

A. The payroll periods and all requirements relative to the twelve month employees shall apply to the summer school employees.

IV. Workshop Employees

Amounts earned for workshops attended shall be reported to the Finance Department on the last day of the workshop and the checks shall be issued on the next regular payroll date provided the workshop shall conclude no less than 5 working days prior to the scheduled issuance of checks.

V. Substitutes

Substitutes are to be reported with the timesheets submitted to the Finance Department and checks are to be issued on the 1st and 16th of each month.

VI. Homebound Instructional Employees

A. Twelve Month Employee

All requirements relative to the twelve month employees shall apply to the summer homebound instructional employees.

B. Ten Month Employee

All requirements relative to the ten month employees shall apply to the regular school term homebound instructional employees.

VII. Issuance of Checks

- A. All checks are to be issued at 10:00 A.M. on the designated dates.
- B. Any date for which checks are scheduled to be issued that falls on a weekend or holiday, the checks shall be issued on the preceding school day except as noted above.
