Is my child eligible to attend Holmes County Virtual School full time?

A student may participate in virtual instruction in Holmes County if:

- * The student spent the prior school year in attendance at a public school in Florida
- * The student is a dependent child of a member of the Armed Forces who has transferred within the last 12 months to this state
- * The student was enrolled during the prior year in a virtual instruction program
- * The student has a sibling who is currently in a virtual education program
- * The student is eligible to enter kindergarten or first grade



What You Need to Know About Holmes Virtual Education

In order to be successful with virtual education, you **MUST**

- ◇ Be able to navigate the web
- ◇ Have average to above average English reading skills
- ◇ Attend class and be ready to work daily on your course
- ◇ Complete all assignments independently
- ◇ Track your progress
- ◇ Treat your fellow students, lab techs, and teachers with respect
- ◇ Get help when you need it.

Important:

- * ***Students enrolled in full time instruction in grades k-12 must take all required statewide assessments. Students receiving part time instruction in courses requiring statewide end-of-course assessments must take all required statewide end-of-course assessments.***



- * Students will have up to 10 school days into the semester to withdraw from a course. If students continue in the virtual program after the 10 school day drop option, they will not be allowed to return to a traditional classroom but must remain in the virtual course until the end of the semester. In the case of special circumstances, a review will be conducted by administration and guidance to make a determination.
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
